Assess the Current Capabilities

- > Identify the state of your current technology stack.
- > Identify the key technical challenges or opportunities.
- Map the current customer experience capabilities, such as processes, digital marketing, experience, and customer service.

Business of Tomorrow

- > Define the external/internal input on opportunities and gaps.
- > Identify opportunity space within competition and journey gaps.
- > Map high-impact concepts such as new services, functionalities, and capabilities.

Evaluate your Tech Approach

- > Define your long-term business objectives.
- > Outline your ideas on the minimum first steps you will take to move to composable architecture.
- > Talk with experts and ask for specific pros/cons in your unique scenario.
- > Decide on your delivery model: one partner vs multiple partners, inhouse vs external, and more.
- > Identify costs, like implementation, licenses, and maintenance.
